Background:

Anaphase-promoting complex subunit 4 (ANAPC4) belongs to the APC4 family and is a component of the anaphase promoting complex/cyclosome (APC/C), a cell cycle-regulated E3 ubiquitin ligase that controls progression through mitosis and the G1 phase of the cell cycle. The APC/C complex acts by mediating ubiquitination and subsequent degradation of target proteins: it mainly mediates the formation of 'Lys-11'-linked polyubiquitin chains and, to a lower extent, the formation of 'Lys-48'- and 'Lys-63'-linked polyubiquitin chains.

Source and Purity:

Rabbit polyclonal antibodies were produced by immunizing animals with a GST-fusion protein containing the N-terminal region of human ANAPC4. Antibodies were purified by affinity purification using immunogen.

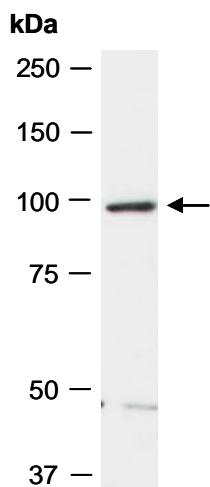


Fig 1. Western blot of total cell extracts from human HeLa, using anti-ANAPC4 (N) (R0869-1) at RT for 2 h.
