Background:

InaD-like protein (INADL) is a protein with multiple PDZ domains. PDZ domains mediate protein-protein interactions, and proteins with multiple PDZ domains often organize multimeric complexes at the plasma membrane. INADL localizes to tight junctions and to the apical membrane of epithelial cells. A similar protein in *Drosophila* is a scaffolding protein which tethers several members of a multimeric signaling complex in photoreceptors [provided by RefSeq].

Source and Purity:

Rabbit polyclonal antibodies were produced by immunizing animals with a GST-fusion protein containing the C-terminal region of human INADL. Antibodies were purified by affinity purification using immunogen.

Supplied in 1 x PBS (pH 7.4), 100 ug/ml BSA, 40% Glycerol, 0.01% NaN₃. Store at -20 °C. Stable for 6 months from date of receipt.

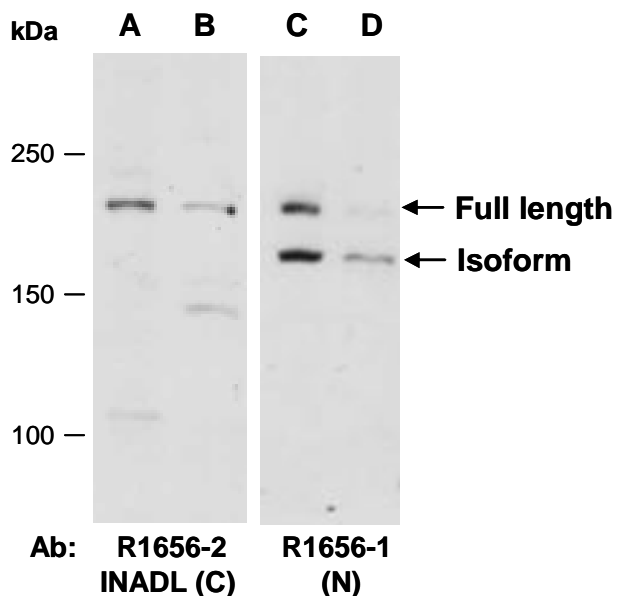


Fig 1. Western blot of total cell extracts from (A, C) human HeLa, (B, D) human Jurkat; using 2 independent Abs against 2 distinct regions of human INADL at RT for 2 h. INADL (C) recognizes the full-length INADL.
