Alpha-1B-glycoprotein (A1BG) is a secreted plasma glycoprotein of unknown function. A1BG shows sequence similarity to the variable regions of some immunoglobulin supergene family member proteins, and it interacts with CRISP3.

Rabbit polyclonal antibodies were produced by immunizing animals with a GST-fusion protein containing C-terminal region of human A1BG. Antibodies were purified by affinity purification using immunogen.

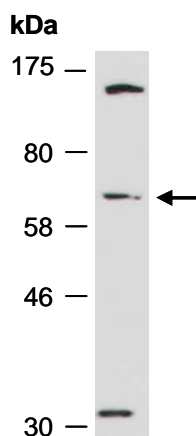


Fig 1. Western blot of total cell extracts from human HeLa; using anti-A1BG (C1) (R3306-2) at RT for 2 h. This Ab recognizes the 68 kD glycosylated A1BG.
